English

Science

In History, Class 3 will focus on the Victorian era, specifically looking at a local study on artist Norman Cornish.



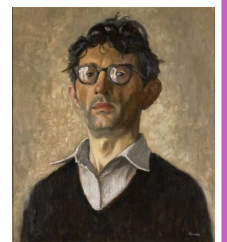
Computing
